ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE 2009-02

IN RE: FAMILY LAW DIVISION ROTATION - ESCAMBIA COUNTY

O R D E R

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Escambia County Family Law Division (FLD) and the allocation of judicial resources for that division was addressed in Administrative Order No. 95-104: and

WHEREAS, the Escambia County Judicial Rotation Policy requires that judicial rotation of FLD judges must be addressed the 1st day of April each year; and

WHEREAS, the judges affected by the Escambia County Judicial Rotation Policy have determined rotation to be appropriate as hereafter set forth; effective April 1, 2009, it is

ORDERED that:

1. Judge Kenneth L. Williams shall be re-assigned from Division "L" to handle Division "D" criminal, civil, probate and guardianship cases.
2. Judge Michael G. Allen shall be re-assigned from Division "D" to handle Division "L" family law cases.
3. Judge Jan Shackelford shall continue the assignment handling Division "F" criminal cases and shall be assigned to handle Division "O" juvenile and related cases.
4. Judge W. Joel Boles shall continue the assignment in Division "E" handling criminal cases and all Division "F" civil, probate, and guardianship cases shall be re-assigned to and re-designated Division "E" cases.

5. Judge Ross Goodman shall continue the assignment handling Division "H" juvenile and related cases.
6. Because the effective date of rotation is on a Wednesday during the week rotation is scheduled, the affected judges may cover the docket of the division from which or to which they rotate to accommodate continuity of scheduling issues in their joint discretion.
